

# Accelerate – Shopify Integration Instructions


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ACCELERATE

This document will cover the initial steps and requirements for establishing connection between your Shopify store and your RepSpark B2B website.

## Install the RepSpark Private App and generate the API keys

1. Log In to your Shopify Admin, click on the Apps section, then find the link for 'manage private apps' located near the bottom of the screen.




2. Fill out the App details section
  - a. Name = RepSpark
  - b. Dev email = [success@repspark.com](mailto:success@repspark.com)
3. Admin API section – update App permissions
  - a. Use the table below to set the Permissions for each of the areas.
  - b. You will need to click on “show inactive Admin API permissions” link to expand the list and see all of the options available

The following API permissions need to be granted to RepSpark using your Shopify administrative account.

Access Type	Description
<b>Read and Write Access</b>	Products
<b>Read Access</b>	Customers
<b>Read Access</b>	Shipping
<b>Read Access</b>	Inventory
<b>Read and Write Access</b>	Orders
<b>Read and Write Access</b>	Draft Orders

- c. When finished, press SAVE button

- d. This will create the App and generate the API keys.
4. Locate the API Keys for the RepSpark Private App
    - a. Return to the “manage private apps” link (see step 1)
    - b. Click on “RepSpark” under the private app name
    - c. Here you can see the API credentials listed in the Admin API section, along with the Permissions that you set in step 3.
    - d. To Connect your Shopify Account into RepSpark, you will need just TWO (2) pieces of API data. See the screenshot for where those are located.




- i. Shopify URL – This is the URL location for your Shopify admin. Typically, the format will be **`https://mywebsitename.myshopify.com`**
  - you must copy the `https://` part into RepSpark
  - do not copy anything past the `.com`
- ii. Password – This is hidden in the admin area
  - Press the 'show' button
  - Copy and Paste that value into RepSpark
- iii. See next section for where to connect this data.

## Connect your API Data into RepSpark Admin Dashboard

1. Login to RepSpark, click on Admin Dashboard link
  - a. Step 1: Choose your data source. Choose Shopify
  - b. Or, select “connect data” from the left menu, then select Shopify from the dropdown menu
2. From the Connect Data page, add your Shopify credentials then press SAVE
  - a. See previous section for which 2 pieces of data are needed
  - b. Copy and Paste into the two fields, as shown below.
